Half a million live in state facilities and 70% of those will die before the age of twenty one. In this place every seventh orphan attempts suicide. Two thousand babies are abandoned each year and one in ten teenage girls will fall pregnant... only intensifying the cycle. From the ravages of a communist past... where God was once banished... these children fight all odds to survive each day. Ukraine has become a desperate situation for children - but God has a rescue plan."

He healed on the Sabbath, although it was against protocol, telling the lame man to "Rise, take up your bed and walk" (John 5:7-8).

This angered the religious, stuck in the dreary routine of tradition. Jesus deftly turned the traditionalist argument on its head, explaining that to comply with the law of the fathers; they circumcise a man on the Sabbath. Why then should He not make a man well on the Sabbath?"
